Requests for Promotion or Office Bearer

Introduction:

It is important that any promotions or official assignments made by the ISKK are awarded based on our knowledge of the applicant and their abilities. It is considered inappropriate to accept a person for membership and simultaneously issue them with an upgrade or an official role within the ISKK.

We do, however, receive applications from karateka requesting promotion at membership time.

Proposal:

The usual process will be followed regarding researching the background of any applicant to the ISKK and where this supports the application for membership, it will be offered. At this stage the applicant will accept or reject the offer of membership and if accepted will submit their lifetime membership fee.

Thereafter, no promotions or official assignments will be made within the first year of membership.

Benefits:

This action will help to ensure that only genuine and interested members are allocated the official roles within the ISKK and that any promotions awarded are well founded.
