Proposed Addendum to the Management Process

Item: Researching Potential members

Introduction:

When being approached by applicants unknown to us and geographically inaccessible to existing members, it is a very lengthy task to collate sufficient information in order to propose action to the Shihankai.

This does lead us to lose members as all the research tends to fall to the administration team and we are unable to dedicate our full time to these activities creating bottleneck in the process.

Proposal:

We currently have a Yahoo Discussion Group which we could make available to all potential members from the time they make initial application. If they do join the discussion group and post an introduction then we can get them into a discussion. This would help us all participate in the assessment.

We could set a term of say 2 months to finalise the acceptance and if we cannot do that the applicant will be rejected and removed from the discussion group..

Benefits:

This process chance will allow more people to participate in the assessment and make the decision by the Shihankai better informed. It will also save administration time and give a quicker response of action to the applicant.
